

RIGHT: A NEW radio car tarmac circuit has opened in Hailsham. The Eastbourne Electric Car Club which races 10th Scale radio controlled cars held its first meeting last month with 83 drivers booked in and racing. The track has already attracted some national meetings in its first year and on April 29 brought The Southern Touring Clubmans Cup (S.T.C.C) to the Eastbourne club circuit for round two of the championship with a fully booked meeting of 110 drivers.
